

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Photography Folio Building Workshop

This is a one day folio building workshop

1. What is the duration of the workshop?

- The workshop spans three days, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

2. Where will the workshop be held?

- The workshop will take place at @theStudio 104 Fanshaw St CBD Auckland

3. What equipment should I bring?

- Attendees should bring a DSLR or mirrorless camera, lenses, memory cards, spare batteries a laptop, and any personal photography accessories they wish to use.

4. Are meals provided during the workshop?

- Lunch is provided. There will be scheduled breaks, and attendees are welcome to bring their own snacks and drinks.

5. Is there a dress code for the workshop?

- There is no formal dress code, but attendees should wear clean comfortable tidy clothing suitable for both indoor and outdoor shooting sessions.

6. Will I receive any materials or handouts?

- No handout materials will be given for the Portfolio Building workshop.

7. What if I need to cancel my registration?

- No refunds given. We understand things can happen and we do sympathize. However due to the short start date we can not offer refunds. We can offer credit to another upcoming workshop or you may transfer your ticket to a friend. You will need to notify us immediately of any changes.

8. Will there be hands-on shooting opportunities?

- Yes this is a fully guided photo shoot workshop and practical sessions where attendees can choose their own outfits and experiment with different lighting.

9. Can I use the photos taken during the workshop in my portfolio?

- Yes, attendees retain the rights to the images they take during the workshop for personal and portfolio use. Model releases will be provided if applicable.

10. What topics will be covered in the workshop?

- The workshop will lightly cover technical mastery (camera settings, lighting, composition), creative vision (developing personal style, conceptual photography), and practical experience.

11. Is there a limit on the number of participants?

- Yes, to ensure personalized attention and a quality experience, the workshop is limited to 10 participants.

12. Who will be instructing the workshop?

- The workshop will be led by Keri Little & Rhonda Stove, professional photographers with extensive experience in portfolio building and photographic techniques.

13. Will there be one-on-one time with the instructor?

- Yes, there will be opportunities for one-on-one portfolio reviews and personalized feedback sessions with the instructors.

14. Are there any prerequisites for attending the workshop?

- Attendees should have a basic understanding of photography and familiarity with their camera. Prior experience with photo editing software is beneficial but not required.
